In maths we have been focussing on algebra to secure our understanding of this concept. In English we have been revisiting active and passive sentences, and writing from a stimulus. In History we have been investigating what life was like in Britain after the Romans left and how we need to evaluate sources due to their reliability.

In RE the children have been looking at Diversity and Identity and have been studying what it means to be a good citizen and what it means to be a global citizen. Finally in Science we have been studying Organisms, which has involved us categorising different species into different groups and how we can identify mammals from insects etc.

As I am sure you are aware the SATs exams are in May. Over the Easter holidays the children brought home a 10 4 10 booklet which was to boost their maths further. The aim was for the children to complete 10 minutes of maths for 10 days so that they do not forget all the work we have covered so far. It also means that they practise strategies that they will need to remember. Please ensure that your child has completed these activities.

Finally we will be going swimming after the Easter break on a Monday, children need to remember to come to school with their PE kit on and bring their swimming kit with them. We are looking to our adventures in Wales next week.
