## Children aged 3&4 years - 15 Hours

- · 15 hours of funded childcare, provided over term time only
- · Children must attend Pre-School for a minimum of 5 full days
- Your child will automatically receive 15 hours of funding the term following their 3rd birthday.
- We carefully structure our timetable to help parents maximise their 15 hours of funding.

However, to enjoy the full Preparatory School benefits, additional charges are made for specialist, high-quality teaching provision including Music, French, PE and Dance.

## Children aged 3&4 years - 30 Hours

- 30 hours of funded childcare, provided over term time only
- · Children must attend Pre-School for a minimum of 5 full days

 $\cdot$  Your child will automatically receive 15 hours of funding the term following their 3rd birthday. To claim the additional 15 hours (to make 30), you will need to visit

www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to check your eligibility and apply.

## Little Gems at The Chadderton Free Childcare Funding for 2-year-olds.

We are pleased to offer funding for 2-year-olds at Little Gems Nursery subject to eligibility and availability of places.

Children aged 2 years – 15 Hours

- From April 2024, eligible working parents can access 15 hours of funded childcare a week
- $\cdot$  The funding is claimed over 38 weeks.
- Children must attend Nursery for a minimum of 3 full days Families will need to visit <u>www.childcarechoices.gov.uk</u> to check your eligibility and apply
